RESOLUTION OF THE VENTURA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE CITY OF SIMI VALLEY REORGANIZATION – REAGAN LIBRARY; ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF SIMI VALLEY AND THE VENTURA COUNTY WATERWORKS DISTRICT NO. 8; DETACHMENT FROM THE VENTURA COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT, AND COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 32

WHEREAS, the above-referenced proposal has been filed with the Executive Officer of the Ventura Local Agency Formation Commission pursuant to the Cortese/Knox/Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 (Section 56000 of the California Government Code); and

WHEREAS, at the times and in the manner required by law, the Executive Officer gave notice of the proposal as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the proposal was duly considered on November 18, 2009; and WHEREAS, the Commission heard, discussed and considered all oral and written testimony for and against the proposal including, but not limited to, the LAFCO staff report and recommendation, the environmental document and determination, Sphere of Influence and applicable local plans and polices; and

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that the proposal boundaries include an undeveloped approximately 68-acre parcel (assessor parcel number 500-0-400-355) that receives no public services from the City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura and the City Council of the City of Moorpark acted to retain this 68-acre parcel within the boundaries of the Tiera Rejada Greenbelt; and

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that the annexation of this approximately 68acre parcel to the City of Simi Valley and to Waterworks District No. 8 to be premature at this time; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that there is sufficient capability to provide domestic water and all other urban services on a permanent basis to the reorganization area including the portion of which currently receives domestic water only on a surplus basis; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that Commissioner's Handbook Policy 2.5.1.2 is inapplicable due to exceptional circumstances because the Reagan Library parcel is currently developed and receiving all other City services; and

WHEREAS, all landowners within the affected territory have not consented to the proposal; and

WHEREAS, proof has been given to the Commission that the affected territory has fewer than 12 registered voters and is considered uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, information satisfactory to the Commission has been presented that no subject agency has submitted written opposition to the proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Commission finds the proposal to be in the best interest of the affected area and the organization of local governmental agencies within Ventura County; and

WHEREAS, the Commission certifies that it has reviewed and considered the Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency; and

WHEREAS the Commission has found that the Negative Declaration discloses impacts that are not significant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Ventura Local Agency Formation Commission as follows:

- (1) The LAFCO Staff Report dated November 18, 2009, is adopted.
- (2) The Reorganization, consisting of an annexation to the City of Simi Valley and the Ventura County Waterworks District No. 8 and a detachment of the same territory from the Ventura County Resource Conservation District and County Service Area No. 32, is amended to exclude the 68acre parcel (Assessor Parcel Number 500-0-400-355).
- (3) The amended Reorganization is hereby approved and the boundaries are established generally as set forth in the attached Exhibit A.
- (4) The affected territory is uninhabited as defined by Government Code §56046.

- (5) The subject proposal is assigned the following distinctive short form designation:
 - LAFCO 09-08 CITY OF SIMI VALLEY REORGANIZATION REAGAN LIBRARY.
- (6) The Commission has reviewed and considered the information contained in the Initial Study /Negative Declaration for CSV-ANX-74/Z-S-643 (Ronald Reagan Library annexation) prepared by the City of Simi Valley as lead agency.
- (7) The Commission directs staff to file a Notice of Determination in the same manner as a lead agency under CEQA Guidelines §15094 and §15096(i).
- (8) The Commission determines that the project is in compliance with Government Code § 56741 as the territory to be annexed is located within one county and is contiguous with the boundaries of the City of Simi Valley.
- (9) The Executive Officer is hereby directed to conduct protest proceedings in accordance with Government Code Section 57050.
- (10) The Commission hereby delegates to the Executive Officer the authority to determine the amount of the protest pursuant to Government Code Section 57075(b).
- (11) This annexation shall not be recorded until maps and legal descriptions consistent with this approval and suitable for filing with the State Board of Equalization have been submitted to the LAFCo Executive Officer and certified by the County Surveyor.
- (12) This reorganization shall not be recorded until all LAFCo fees have been paid and until fees necessary for filing with the State Board of Equalization have been submitted to the Executive Officer.


