SUBJECT: Detachment of Territory from the City of Thousand Oaks

Government Code Section 56742 provides LAFCo with the authority to approve an annexation to a city of territory that is noncontiguous to the city boundary so long as the territory is located in the same county as the city, owned by the city, and used for municipal purposes. When any or all of such territory is sold by the city, all of the territory no longer owned by the city shall cease to be part of that city.

In 1994, LAFCo approved the annexation of noncontiguous territory to the City of Thousand Oaks for purposes of municipal water storage. It has come to our attention that in 2010 the City transferred ownership of a portion of this territory (Assessor parcel 673-0-150-730) to Cecilia Byun, a private party (see attached Grant Deed). Pursuant to Government Code § 56742(e), upon the sale of this parcel by the City it ceased to be part of the City.

We request that all maps of the City of Thousand Oaks boundary be corrected to exclude Assessor parcel 673-0-150-730. It is also requested that tax rate area information be updated and/or changed, as necessary.





Dear Mr. Davis:

This office serves as legal counsel for the Ventura Local Agency Formation Commission (Ventura LAFCo). We send this letter to you at the request of Ventura LAFCo staff.

Government Code section 56742 (section 56742), subdivision (a), provides a local agency formation commission with the authority to approve an annexation to a city of territory that is noncontiguous to the city boundary so long as the territory does not exceed 300 acres; is located in the same county as that in which the city is situated; is owned by the city; and is used for municipal purposes at the time commission proceedings are initiated. Section 56742, subdivision (e), provides that "[w]hen any or all of the territory annexed to a city pursuant to this section is sold by the city, all of the territory that is no longer owned by the city shall cease to be a part of that city."

In 1994, Ventura LAFCo approved the annexation of noncontiguous territory to the City of Thousand Oaks (City) for purposes of municipal water storage. Ventura LAFCo staff has recently become aware that the City transferred ownership of a portion of this territory, described as Assessor Parcel Number 673-0-150-730, to a private party in

2010. Pursuant to section 56742, when this parcel was sold by the City, it ceased to be part of the City by operation of law.

Section 56742, subdivision (g), provides, in part, that when territory ceases to be part of a city pursuant to that section, the legislative body of the city shall adopt a resolution confirming the detachment, and the city clerk shall, immediately upon adoption of the resolution, make any filing required by chapter 8 of part 4 of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, commencing with Government Code section 57200. This includes the filing of a statement of boundary change with the Board of Equalization, the county assessor and the county auditor (Gov. Code, § 57204).

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Ventura LAFCo staff was contacted by City staff, who inquired about the process required to detach the above-described territory. In accordance with the provisions of law cited above, LAFCo staff informed City staff that no LAFCo action is required and recommended that the City Clerk file a statement of boundary change directly with the Board of Equalization.

Hi Ralph,

As you may recall, last week we discussed provisions of LAFCo law that provide for the automatic detachment of noncontiguous territory from a city without the need for LAFCo action. The Ventura LAFCo approved the annexation of noncontiguous territory to the City of Thousand Oaks in 1994. The territory, comprised of several individual parcels, was owned by the City and is used for municipal water storage. In 2010, the City sold one of the parcels to a private party. Pursuant to Government Code 56742(e), after the sale of the property, it ceased to be part of the City.

Per your request, attached is a letter from Ventura LAFCo legal counsel regarding this matter. We understand that the City will be pursuing a resolution confirming the detachment in the near future. Please feel free to contact me should you have any questions.

Hi Jeff,

Sections 57200 through 57203 deal with the filing requirements for a Certificate of Completion, which is a document that applies to LAFCo actions. Because LAFCo took no action as part of this detachment, it appears that these sections would not apply. Section 57204 provides for the filing of a statement of boundary change with the Board of Equalization (BOE), the county assessor, and the county auditor. A statement of boundary change is a BOE document that can, it appears, be filed by the city. We've attached a copy of a statement of boundary change form. We took the liberty of filling in some of the sections for you. Let me know if you have any questions or contact Ralph Davis at the BOE at 916-274-3257. When filing the statement, you may want to include the letter from LAFCo legal counsel which I copied to you under a separate email.

As we discussed last week, according to Ralph Davis at the BOE, the property description and map cited in 56742(g) need to meet the standards of the map/legal description prepared for annexations.

I have been asked to prepare a resolution to confirm the detachment of the reservoir site from the City of Thousand Oaks as specified below in GC Sec. 56742. This section directs the City Clerk to make any filing required by Chapter 8 (commencing with Sec. 57200) of Part 4. I could not find this filing requirement. Do you know what it is?

Government Code Sec. 56742

(q) When territory ceases to be part of a city pursuant to this section, the legislative body of the city shall adopt a resolution confirming the detachment. The resolution shall describe the detached territory and shall be accompanied by a map indicating the territory. Immediately upon adoption of the resolution, the city clerk shall make any filing required by Chapter 8 (commencing with Section 57200) of Part 4.
